The suitable candidates will be able to perform the following duties:

- Perform vehicle and foot patrols for signs of suspicious behavior, theft, vandalism and forced entry.
- Monitor office complexes, facilities and homes to ensure safety of the general public;
- Work independently in a high-stress environment with minimal supervision;
- Provide written and verbal reports with attention to factual details;
- Prepare incident reports and daily logs.
- Other duties of a similar nature as may be assigned from time to time.
