Lac La Ronge Indian Band is now accepting applications for the following full-time **term** position for the 2018-2019 school year with the possibility of extension. This position will be based out of the La Ronge Band Office:

EDUCATION PSYCHOLOGIST

The Education Psychologist, under the direction of the Superintendent of Schools (Special Education), will primarily be responsible for providing educational psychology services to LLRIB schools including consultations with children, families and school staff, psycho-educational assessments, psychological counseling, educational intervention, mediation, coordination, and referral to other professionals. Educational Psychology services will be provided to the LLRIB educational community including students, teachers, parents and academic authorities.

Duties (includes but not limited to):

- Promote the use of psychology to improve the outcomes and emotional well-being of children and young people.
- To work with schools to provide children and staff with an educational psychology service. This will include, as necessary, direct work with children and families, advice, consultation and support to schools in the general application of evidence-based psychological practice and systems.
- To provide an educational psychology service to children in the early years for early intervention and prevention. This work will include, as necessary, direct work with children and families, consultation and support in the general application of psychology and appropriate inputs to training for professionals involved with this group.
- To advise about individual children with special needs. This will include all aspects of statutory assessment tasks.
- To contribute to differentiated programs of staff development to support diverse strategies that meet all students' needs.
- To keep accurate, up to date records of all contacts and work relating to children, young people and their families in accordance with service protocols.
- To liaise with other services and outside agencies as an advocate for students with special needs services.
- Advise and support colleagues in order to share experience and knowledge. To initiate and contribute to projects and research at a local and strategic level.
- To take part in meetings, including service and team, and with the Educational Psychology Service.
- It will be necessary to work with information technology and associated systems in accordance with policies.

Requirements:

- Masters Degree in Educational Psychology.
- Registered with Saskatchewan College of Psychologists.
- Authorized practice endorsement.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- A broad knowledge of child development and teaching methods.
- Cultural sensitivity.
- Ability to speak Cree language would be an asset.
- Ability to recognize individual learning styles and the characteristics of learners.
- Strong working knowledge of Microsoft software, including Word, Excel, etc.
- Ability to provide satisfactory Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sector Check.
- Valid Class 5 driver license.
