The Lac La Ronge Indian Band Education Department is now accepting applications for the following full-time **term** positions for the 2018-2019 school year with the possibility of extension.

These positions will be based out of Bell's Point Elementary School, La Ronge, SK:

SPEECH LANGUAGE INTERVENTIONIST/TEACHER **Two (2) Positions**

The Speech Language Interventionist/Teacher, under the direction of the Principal will primarily be responsible for providing language instruction in collaboration with a Speech Language Pathologist (SLP), Special Education Teacher and teaching staff.

Duties (includes but not limited to):

- Organize and file a variety of classroom materials and educational aids to support language development.
- Support language acquisition strategies and designing of oral literacy supports.
- Assist individual students in performing activities initiated by the teacher.
- Assist in monitoring supplementary work and independent study.
- Reinforce learning in small groups or with individuals, while the teacher works with other students.
- Provide assistance with individualized program materials.
- Assist the teacher in observing, recording and charting behaviour.
- Assist the teacher with crisis problems and behaviour management.
- Assist in preparation/production of instructional materials and modifications.
- Carry out instructional programs designed by the SLP/Spec Ed supports.
- Work with the teacher to develop classroom schedules/home visit schedules.
- Carry out tutoring activities designed by the SLP/Spec Ed supports.
- Assist with strategies to include and involve the students with special needs in classroom and extra-curricular activities.
- Maintain records relative to specific programming and student performance as requested by the teacher/supervisor.
- Supervise and/or participate with students in community-based programming when requested and commit to the regular school staff requirements for areas of extra-curricular.

Requirements:

- Bachelor of Education degree and a Saskatchewan Professional A teaching certificate;
- 3-5 years teaching experience;
- Good classroom management skills;
- Ability to teach students of varying abilities;
- Early Childhood experience is an asset;
- Cross – Cultural experience is an asset;
- Valid Class 5 Driver's License;
- Must be able to provide a satisfactory Driver's Abstract, Criminal Record Check/Vulnerable Sector Screening;
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills;
- A broad knowledge of child development and teaching methods;
- Ability to speak Cree language would be an asset;
- Ability to recognize individual learning styles and the characteristics of learners;
