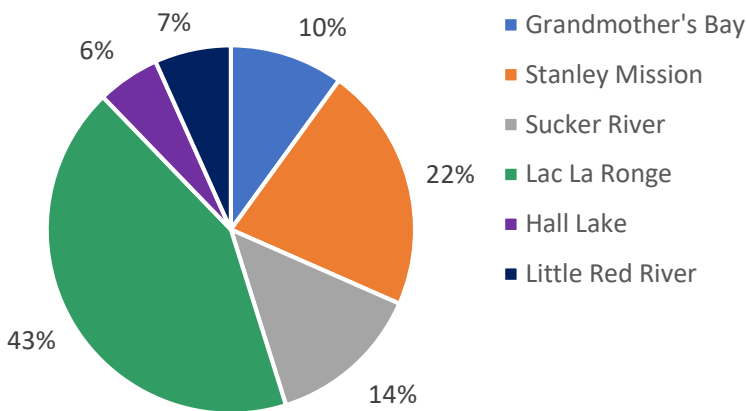




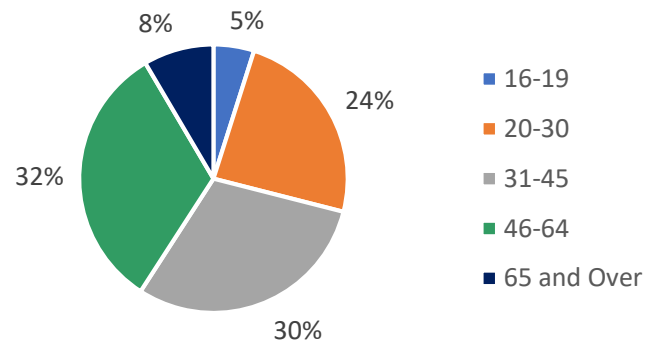
Community Survey Response Summary

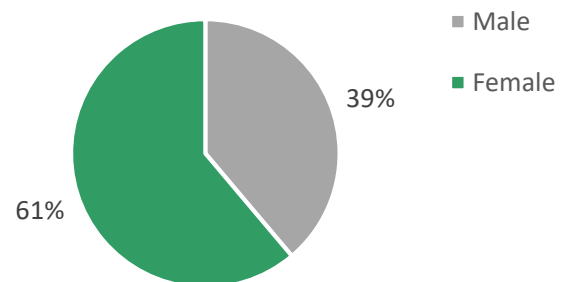
Respondents Home Community:



Respondents Age:



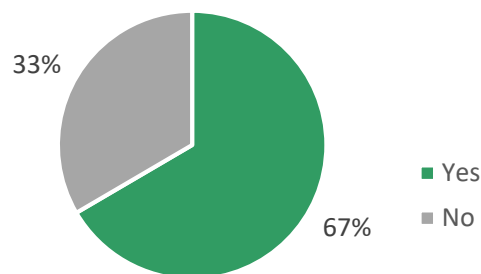

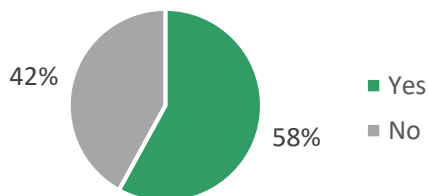

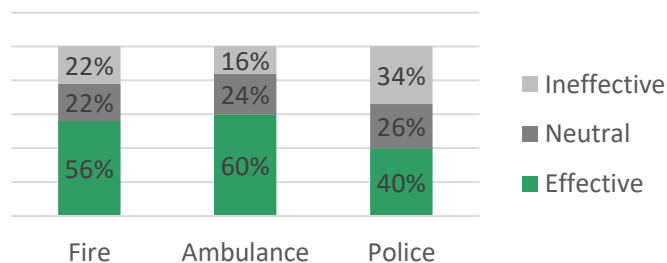

How effective are emergency services in your community?



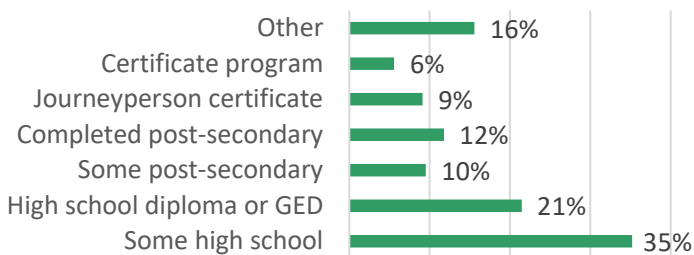
What are your concerns with emergency services in your community?

- Need community security services

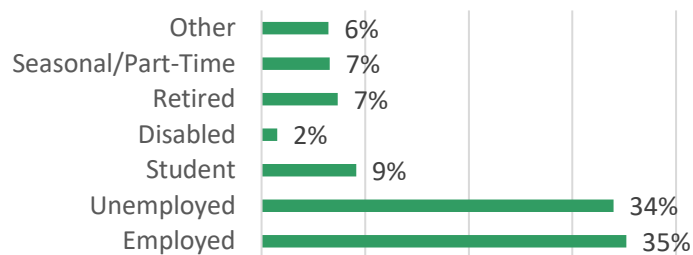

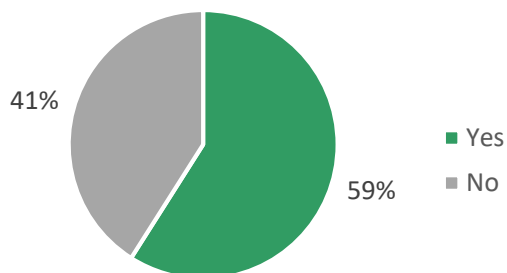

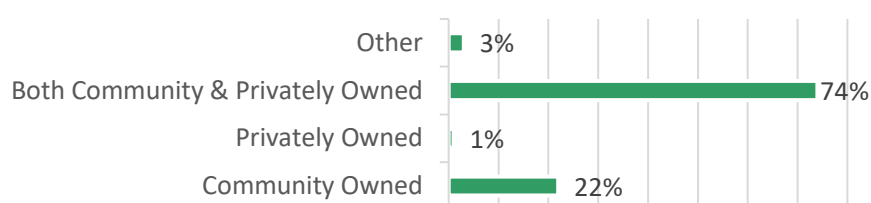
What improvements could be made to community infrastructure and services?

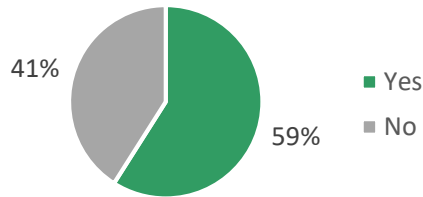

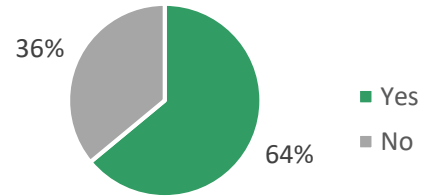

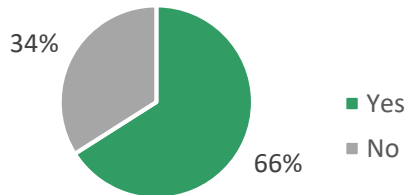
Does your current housing situation meet you, or your family's needs?



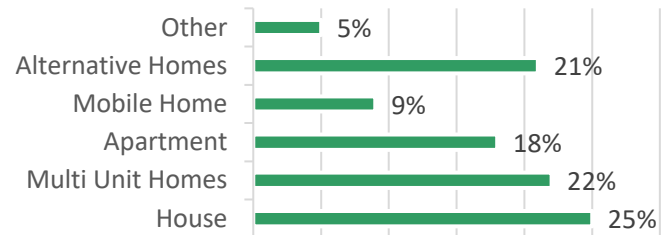
Are there repairs or renovations required in your home?

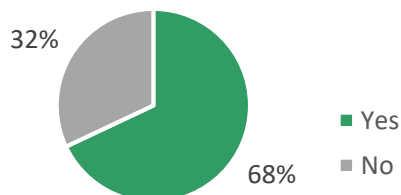
