Purpose of Position

Under the supervision of Director of Education. The Web Developer is responsible for designing, coding and modifying websites from layout to functions and according to the LLRIB's specifications. The suitable candidate will strive to create visually appealing sites that feature user-friendly design and clear navigation.

WEB DEVELOPER

Duties include (but not limited to):

- Write well designed, testable, efficient code by using best software development practice;
- Create website layout/user interface by using standard HTML/CSS practices;
- Integrate data from various back-end services and databases;
- Gather and refine specifications and requirements based on technical needs;
- Be responsible for maintaining, expanding and scaling LLRIB's website;
- Test the website and identify any technical problems;
- Upload the site onto a server and register it with different search engine;
- Test sites and applications in different browsers and environments;
- Fix bugs in existing website;
- Test features thoroughly to ensure they perform the correct tasks in all cases;
- Run performance benchmark tests;
- Build and test Application Program Interfaces (APIs) for applications to exchange data;
- Stay up to date with new advancements in web development;
- Recommend and implement performance improvements;
- Identify problems uncovered by the testing or user feedback, and fix problems or refer the problems to appropriate personnel for correction;
- Evaluate codes to ensure that it is valid, is properly structured, meets industry standards and is compatible with browsers, devices or operating systems;
- Develop website maps, application models, image templates, or page templates that meet goals, user needs and LLRIB standards.

Job Requirements

- Minimum two year diploma/certificate in computer science or related field;
- Minimum three years experience in web developing;
- Demonstrated understanding of web applications including security, session management and best development practices;
- Hands-on experience with network diagnostics and network analytics tools;
- Basic knowledge of Search Engine Optimization Process;
- Aggressive problem diagnosis and creative problem solving skills;
- Strong organizational skills to juggle multiple tasks within the constraints of timeliness;
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills;
- Ability to maintain confidentiality;
- Must provide a satisfactory Criminal Record Check, Vulnerable Sector Check and Driver's Abstract;
- Must have a valid Driver's License and reliable.
