Child and Youth Mental Health Trauma Therapist

Lac La Ronge Indian Band Health Services – Prevention and Recovery Program, is looking for a highly skilled, experienced and enthusiastic Mental Health professional to provide direct clinical service, outreach and case management to children/youth ages 0-18 and their families under our Jordon's Principal Program "Child and youth Holistic and Culturally Responsive Mental Health Services".

Primary Responsibilities and Duties

- Extensive experience in counseling survivors of sexual abuse; residential school survivors and their families
- Extensive knowledge of family violence treatment, Posttraumatic stress disorder (PTSD), trauma treatment and processing of negative emotions, sexual abuse assessments and therapeutic interventions.
- Provide trauma-focused counseling and trauma recovery therapeutic services for children, youth and adults for sexual abuse, severe physical abuse, and/or witnessing violence.
- Provide trauma-focused counseling and trauma recovery therapy services for children, youth and adults with Post Traumatic Stress (PTS) relating to unresolved trauma – emotionally, mentally and physically and the spiritual effects of trauma on the individual.
- Ability to make appropriate assessments and treatment plans based on a holistic approach, evaluate treatment progress and outcomes make appropriate referrals as required
- Facilitate support and therapy groups for children, youth and non-offending caregivers
- Evaluate needs of the child and family and provide appropriate referrals and information
- Maintain accurate and timely case notes and record of all client contacts
- Provide accurate statistical reports monthly
- Work closely with other Multidisciplinary team members to provide support for children, youth and families.
- Perform other duties within the scope of this position as assigned by the Program Coordinator

Requirements:

- Master's degree in Aboriginal Social Work, Psychology or a related field
- Must be registered and in good standing with a licensed Professional Association
- Must maintain personal and professional liability Insurance
- Minimum 3 years of experience providing professional counseling to families
- Minimum of five (5) years of clinical experience working in child and youth mental health services with responsibility for providing a wide range of community based mental health services.
- Two (2) years of post – master's degree experience working in child and youth mental health services, with responsibility for providing a wide range of community based mental health services.
- Experience working with First Nations people and communities.
- Extensive training and experience in Critical Incident Stress debriefing (CISD)
- Extensive training and experience in processing traumatic experiences
- Knowledge of various therapeutic and counselling modalities.
- Experience in integrating traditional and contemporary counselling approaches
- Knowledge of assessment and screening tools and modalities in determining risk and threat.
- An understanding of rural and remote communities and their challenges and barriers.
