Transition Recovery Worker

Lac La Ronge Indian Band Health Services – Prevention and Recovery Program, is looking for a Transition Recovery Worker to provide support to clients who are receiving physiological-withdrawal management from opiates, and/or seeking support to access suitable treatment to maintain or achieve sobriety from an opiate.

Primary Responsibilities and Duties

- Conduct program activities including, but not limited to, intake/assessments, case management, holistic wellness activities and exit interviews;
- Evaluate needs of clients and provide appropriate referrals and information
- Maintain accurate and timely case notes and record of all client contacts
- Provide monthly/quarterly reports
- Work closely with other Multidisciplinary team members to provide client support
- Perform other duties within the scope of this position as assigned by the Program Coordinator

Requirements:

- Minimum Certificate in Mental Health and Addictions, Social Work or a related field;
- Minimum two (2) years of experience in Case Management or outreach services of chronic addictions and/or mental health issues;
- Strong organizational skills, ability to multi-task and collaborate as a strong team member;
- Experience in coordinating and facilitating one on one meetings and prevention campaigns;
- A high standard of confidentiality in handling sensitive information;
- Experience working in a First Nations organization an asset;
