



## Working Capital (Short-term Health)



- Are we increasing our 'value'?
  - Total Financial Assets
    - (Anything you own that will be converted to cash)
  - Total Liabilities
    - (Everything that you have to pay to others)
  - The difference between
    - If positive, then net financial assets
    - If negative, then net debt




### **Net Financial Assets / Net Debt**

- If positive, net financial assets
  - Indicates that you can spend past revenues
- If negative, net debt
- Indicates that you need to use future revenues to pay for something you already bought




### Invested in Capital Assets (Ability to provide future services)




### **Total Revenue**







# **2016 Revenues by Source**





# **Expenses by Segment**


