


Stanley Mission – Survey Response Summary

Respondents Gender:




What do you like most about your community?





- Need an ambulance in the community


- · Volunteer fire fighters need more training


Respondents Highest Level of Education:






Does your current housing situation meet you, or your family's needs?




Are you interested in a home ownership option in your community?


