RULES/ELIGIBILITY:

- Candidates must be a LLRIB Member and reside in the respective community he/she will represent as of December 31, 2020.**
- Candidates must be able to demonstrate relevant experience, knowledge, abilities, attributes, or skills.
- Candidates must have a satisfactory criminal record check (CRC) completed in the last 6 months.
- Candidates should not have any outstanding debt to the band (including entities, and corporations to which LLRIB is the majority shareholder) or has an existing agreement to repay the debt.
- Candidates must live a healthy lifestyle and be a positive role model.
- Candidates are allowed to be a member of up to two elected advisory committees.
- Candidates cannot run, nominate, or second for a committee if they are employed by that department.
- Candidates must be able to attend meetings independently (transportation will not be provided).
- Additional requirements for Education Advisory Committees:
 - must be a parent/grandparent/legal guardian of a child within the LLRIB school system;
 - must have at least a high school diploma or certificate of high school equivalency; and
 - provision of a vulnerable sector screening check.
