

Participants Needed for Research Study







We are recruiting Lac La Ronge Indian Band members to participate in the COVID CommUNITY Study! This will help us learn about the effectiveness & safety of the COVID-19 vaccine over time, and how the pandemic has impacted community members. All are welcome to join regardless whether you've had the vaccination or not.



Your participation would involve two activities completed twice: when you enter the study and again 6 months later. You would be asked to:

- Complete a questionnaire about yourself (e.g. age, your health, whether you have been sick with COVID, why did you get the vaccine or why not, etc.)
- Provide a dried blood spot sample. This is done through a prick to your finger in a manner similar to a blood sugar test.

You can participate from the comfort of your own home or at one of the LLRIB clinics. Our staff can help you in person or over the phone.





You may qualify if you are:

- 18 years of age or older
- a Lac La Ronge Indian Band member



Participants will receive \$25.00 for finishing the first study activities and again for completing everything a second time 6 months later. Plus a chance to win some neat prizes!
