Summary of Proposed LLRIB Election Act Amendments

In 2019, after multiple rounds of consultation in all the LLRIB communities, Saskatoon and Prince Albert, the LLRIB Election Act was amended to better reflect the needs of the Nation when running an election.

The 2019 Election Act was used for the first time in 2020, during the global Covid-19 pandemic. After that election, the Election Tribunal met to discuss and review the election, and propose the following main amendments to the LLRIB Election Act:

Current Act	Proposed Amendment
No provision for electronic voting	Provides for electronic voting to any member who wants to vote electronically (on-reserve and off)
Prohibits Candidates from running if they have any debt with the Nation or a band-owned entity	Candidates cannot have more than \$1000 in debt outstanding to LLRIB (including LLRIB entities, businesses, and corporations to which LLRIB is the majority shareholder) and must have an existing agreement to repay any debt below \$1000
Appeals are facilitated by the Election Tribunal	Creation of a separate three-member Election Appeals Committee
Nominations of Candidates can only be made in person at a nomination meeting	Candidates can be nominated in person, or in advance by using a form (delivered in person, by email or mail)
No provision for a code of conduct for campaigning	Creation of a Code of Conduct During Elections Campaign (Part 8)

Other amendments are proposed, and include amendments to forms, and amendments for clarity and ease of understanding. All amendments are tracked in the Election Act (posted online and copies will be available at community meetings).
