An Environmental Management Plan (EMP) is a member-driven statement of goals, actions, and strategies that a First Nation will pursue to maintain or improve environmental quality on reserves.

- 1. What environmental concerns, issues, or impacted/polluted areas on reserve lands are you aware of that should be addressed in the Environmental Management Plan?**

- 2. Of those environmental concerns you mentioned above, which one(s) should be considered a priority in the EMP and why? Also, who do you think should be responsible for taking action to address these concerns?**

The information collected from community members will be summarized in the Environmental Management Plan document, and will be used to help inform selection of environmental concerns, priorities, and management actions. Your personal information will not be shared.



- 3. Are there specific aspects of the environment or areas on reserve that are not currently impacted, but are at risk of being impacted that should be included in the Environmental Management Plan?**

- 4. Do you know of any traditional or cultural values, practices, language, or teachings that you would like to see included in the EMP, which could help protect your lands, natural resources, and people? What are they?**

Sharing information about the EMP and seeking input from members to develop and implement the actions and strategies identified is an important aspect to the success of the Plan. **We need your help** in developing this plan. The EMP is for all the people of LLRIB. LLRIB leadership and the Lands and Resources Department are looking to you for guidance on how best to share information and seek input from membership about environmental goals and actions and how to implement those actions in the future.
