LLRIB Housing's zero-tolerance policy against drugs and crime

La Ronge, January 20, 2023 (Friday): Chief and Council reiterates Lac La Ronge Indian Band's no-compromise, non-negotiable stand against drug-related and/or any other illegal activities within the jurisdiction of the Band's six communities and 19 reserves.

The membership is reminded that all people residing in homes (including Band-administered and privately-owned homes) on LLRIB land in communities that fall under the Lac La Ronge Indian Band Housing Policy (the Policy) of February 2020 (amended on July 6, 2021), are governed by this Policy. Occupants and borrowers, if found "trafficking narcotics or carrying out other illegal business activities in or from a unit", invite immediate eviction without prior notice.

The Policy's Part 9, Sub-Section 9.8, under *Breach of the Policy, Occupancy Agreement*, states: Occupants and Borrowers in a Unit may be evicted immediately and without notice and counselling for any of the following reasons:

- a) making false declarations on a Housing Application or under the Home Ownership qualification provisions of this Policy that results in a housing allocation or loan guarantee approval;
- b) trafficking narcotics or carrying out other illegal business activities in or from a Unit;
- c) being convicted of a serious criminal code offence; or
- d) being BCR'd from LLRIB reserves.

Substance abuse and alcoholism threaten not just an individual's health, safety and peace of mind but our way of life, traditional values and drain precious resources. We deserve an environment free of crime and negative influence of drugs. We don't, and won't, tolerate drugs and crime in our community.

The LLRIB Chief and Council is committed to creating and maintaining a crime-free community. We appeal to one and all to help us in our efforts.
